**SUNDAY READINGS: 25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**  
Unemployment is not a strictly modern phenomenon. In Jesus' day those who had no regular work went to the village marketplace every morning, hoping to find a day's labour in a landed man's fields or vineyards. It was a buyer's market. Day labourers worked for whatever they were given. The basic premise of Jesus' story, then, was as familiar to His first hearers as it is to us today.

The story's sting is in its tail. The logic of human injustice requires that those who work a full day receive a full day's wage, while those who work one hour receive one hour's pay. It is not so in the kingdom of God. Those who have laboured in the ways of righteousness from early morning receive their full reward. But the prostitutes and tax collectors and sinners who arrive at the eleventh hour receive no less. The laws of human justice are workable enough under ordinary circumstances, but, as the prophet Isaiah suggests, they are too narrow to contain the always astonishing love of God.

The Church is the servant of the kingdom of God, bound by the kingdom's laws we are commanded to invite to supper not only those who have earned a place by their long fidelity but also all those who have just arrived at the gate. The good and the respectable may grumble a bit to find themselves cheek-by-jowl at the Lord's table with sinners. But the host asks, "I am free to do as I please... am I not? Or are you envious because I am generous?"

| <div> <p><b><u>The Mass: Our Intimate Encounter with the Transcendent Lord</u></b><br/> <b><u>by Most Reverend James Conley</u></b> (con't...)</p> <p><b>In the Mass, God Gives Himself to Us (Communion)</b></p> <p>The idea of Jesus giving us His flesh to eat was scandalous to his Jewish listeners, many of whom “returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him” after this teaching (John 6:66). And it remains unbelievable to many modern Christians who consider the Eucharist merely a symbol. But for Catholics, “The Eucharist is ‘the source and summit of the Christian life’” (CCC 1324) because it is our most intimate encounter with the Lord.</p> <p>Jesus’ teaching is crystal clear: “For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him” (John 6:55–56)—when we receive the Lord in Holy Communion, we abide in Him and He abides in us.</p> <p>During the Mass, when we hear the words, “This is my body,” and “This is the chalice of my blood”—through the priest Christ makes Himself truly present and offers to unite with us. As Pope Benedict XVI wrote, “In the Eucharist Jesus does not give us a ‘thing,’ but himself.” In other words, built into the Mass is a powerful encounter with the Lord, who offers us the most intimate relationship possible on earth.</p> <p>Interestingly, Christ’s immanence in the Eucharist is itself an expression of His transcendence. Since Jesus is the eternal Son of God, He can be wholly present on thousands of altars simultaneously across time so that His one sacrifice can be made sacramentally present for the rest of human history. Since He is God, Christ can veil His infinite glory and give us His resurrected flesh to eat. God is so great that He can become small without ceasing to be great!</p> <p>Now, let’s step back for a moment and ask why the God of the universe chose to encounter us under the humble appearances of bread and wine. It’s unexpected and almost embarrassingly material.</p> <p>St. Thomas Aquinas explains, “It was fitting that God should provide man with a spiritual medicine by means of certain corporeal signs; for if man were offered spiritual things without a veil, his mind being taken up with the material world would be unable to apply itself to them.” God teaches us through material things precisely because we are a mix of the corporeal and spiritual, we are body and soul. Jesus’ parables are filled with concrete images—sheep, a sower spreading seed, wineskins, a prodigal son—because we ascend to immaterial concepts through material ones. Likewise, we better understand spiritual truths through the material—so when we are baptized into Christ, it is through water; when we are anointed in sickness, it is with oil; and when we are offered union with Christ, it is through changed bread and wine.</p> <p>But God could’ve chosen anything material; why did He choose food? Perhaps the most obvious reason is that food nourishes us, and Jesus desires to nourish us body and soul. When we eat food, it becomes part of us. Yet when we receive the Eucharist, we don’t merely assimilate Jesus into ourselves—we are assimilated into Him. St. Augustine explains this mystery from Jesus’ perspective when he writes, “I am the food of the grown. Grow, and you shall feed upon Me. Nor shall you change Me into yourself like bodily food, but you shall be changed into Me.”</p> <p>Food also plays an important role in the Bible. Meals are used to establish friendship, peace, and offer hospitality. More importantly, meals are used to create communion through covenants. During the Last Supper, Jesus transformed the Passover into the New Covenant meal (see Matthew 26:28) and sealed that covenant with His sacrifice on Calvary. St. Paul expresses this truth when he asks, “The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ?” (1 Corinthians 10:16). When we receive the Eucharist, we truly share in Christ Himself—and all this through the ordinary (but changed) means of bread and wine.</p> <p>With all this in mind, we might understandably ask: why does the Lord desire to be with us <i>this much</i>? It’s simple: because He loves us, and love desires union. Separation and division pains those who love each other and, in addition to coming to dwell in us through baptism, Jesus desires the union that can only come from being one with us in body and soul, however briefly. The Eucharist, our greatest moment of intimacy with the Lord on earth, anticipates our eternal and complete union with Him in Heaven.</p> <p>The Lord also wants to be with us because He knows He’s the only one that can make us truly happy. St. John Henry Newman wrote:</p> <p>“man is not sufficient for his own happiness; he is not happy except the Presence of God be with him. When he was created, God breathed into him that supernatural life of the Spirit which is his true happiness; and when he fell, he lost the divine gift, and with it his happiness also. Ever since he has been unhappy; ever since he has a void within him which needs filling, and he knows not how to fill it.”</p> <p>God alone can fill that void—and He is eager to fill it with His Real Presence—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.
